
#### Introduction

Dalton State College is located in Dalton, Georgia and serves Northwest Georgia by offering associate, certificate, and targeted baccalaureate programs of study and a wide variety of public service and continuing education activities. Dalton State College currently enrolls just under 5,000 students and employs approximately 400 faculty and staff.

Since December 2005 Dalton State College has annually submitted an Information Technology Security Plan in keeping with Board of Regents Policy 712.03(b) Institutional Responsibilities. These annual Information Technology Security Plans followed guidelines established by OIIT and the ACIT Security Advisory Group and were largely a collection of the College's security policies and procedures. Beginning March 2009, the USG Chief Information Security Officer, Stan Gatewood, called for each unit of the University System of Georgia to implement a comprehensive Information Security Program and annually submit a Strategic Information Security Plan. This strategic plan summarizes the set of goals for program implementation and oversight to launch an Information Security Program.

Establishing an Information Security Program is not a one-time event but an ongoing venture that follows a cyclical process-a journey. The implementation phases (see below) are not cleanly separated processes but instead represent a flow of activities that yield a continuously improving program. The implementation cycle involves establishing information security requirements, educating people about their responsibilities under those requirements, building governance structures to ensure Program compliance, and monitoring and reporting of progress.

- 4. Develop a Computer Security Incident Response Plan
- 5. Implement a Comprehensive Security Awareness and Training Program
- 6. Develop a Continuity of Operations and Disaster Recovery Plan

#### Goal 1: Establish an Information Security Program

**Strategy:** Establish an IT Governance/Security Committee.
