1999 ALUMNI SURVEY RESULTS SUMMARY REPORT*

Highlights

- 460 surveys were sent to Dalton State College alumni. 60 surveys were returned for sending to the wrong address. 110 alumni responded to survey, close to 30% of total respondents.
- A majority (95%) currently live in Georgia. Almost 65% of respondents are female. 27% (the majority) graduated in 1996.
- About 43% of alumni now hold an Associate degree. 31% hold the bachelor's degree.
- Of the alumni currently employed, 93% are employed full-time. 73% said a college degree or certificate was required to obtain their jobs. Almost 60% felt that Dalton State College prepared them "Very Well" for their current position. Close to 50% work in a healthcare and education related fields.
- Overall, 64% of the alumni surveyed rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State College as "Excellent." 75% indicated that their general attitude toward Dalton State College was "Very Positive." 98% said they would recommend the College to others.
- If they could start college over, 66% said they would definitely choose to attend Dalton State College.
- In general, 73% rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State College as "Very Satisfied."
