

#### 2002 GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT

#### Highlights

- 197 graduates responded to the survey. The total number of degrees and certificates conferred in 2001-2002 was 367.
- 65 % of responding graduates were female. 57% of respondents were enrolled full-time while attending Dalton State College.
- 49 % of students worked while attending Dalton State College; 34% worked 36 or more hours per week.
- 74% of respondents reported that their objective for attending Dalton State College was fully accomplished.
- A slight majority (29%) completed their degree or certificated program in two years.
- 71% of respondents said their immediate plans after graduation was to obtain further education.
- 29% of respondents indicated that they were "extremely well" prepared for continuing their education.
- 30% of respondents who entered the labor force said that their new job was "directly related" to their program of study.
- 42% of respondents rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State College as "Excellent."
- 37% of respondents indicated that their overall impression/attitude of Dalton State College was "Very Positive."
- 80% of respondents indicated that they would recommend Dalton State College to someone who wanted to major in their program.
- 44% indicated that if they could start college over, they would "definitely" choose to attend Dalton State College.
- Overall, 49% of respondents rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State College as "Very Satisfied."
