

# 2004 GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT

#### **Highlights**

- 268 graduates responded to the survey. The total number of degrees and certificates conferred in 2003-2004 was 467.
- 75.9 % of responding graduates were female. 64.2 % of respondents were enrolled full-time, 35.8 % were enrolled part-time while attending Dalton State College.
- 35.5 % of students worked Work on campus while attending Dalton State College; 54 % worked off-campus while attending Dalton State College, 35 % worked 36 or more hours per week.
- 79.4 % of respondents reported that their objective for attending Dalton State College was fully accomplished.
- A slight majority (37.7 %) completed their degree or certificated program in two years.
- 48.4 % of respondents said their immediate plans after graduation was to obtain further education.
- 36.5 % of respondents indicated that they were "extremely well" prepared for continuing their education.
- 61.7 % of respondents who entered the labor force said that their new job was "directly related" to their program of study.
- 51.6 % of respondents rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State College as "Excellent."
- 45.6 % of respondents indicated that their overall impression/attitude of Dalton State College was "Very Positive."
- 90.7% of respondents indicated that they would recommend Dalton State College to someone who wanted to major in their program.
- 59.9 % indicated that if they could start college over, they would "definitely" choose to attend Dalton State College.
- Overall, 88.8 % of respondents rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State College as "Very Satisfied" or "Satisfied".
