

# 2005 GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT

#### Highlights

- 234 graduates responded to the survey. The total number of degrees and certificates conferred in 2004-2005 was 456. Response rate for survey is 51.3%.
- 80.4% of responding graduates were female. 66.5% of respondents were enrolled full-time, 33.5% were enrolled part-time while attending Dalton State College.
- 26.8% of students worked on campus while attending Dalton State College; 61.6% worked off-campus while attending Dalton State College, 31% worked 36 or more hours per week.
- 79.3% of respondents reported that their objective for attending Dalton State College was fully accomplished.
- A slight majority (29.5%) completed their degree or certificated program in two years.
- 52.4% of respondents said their immediate plans after graduation was to obtain further education.
- 34.6% of respondents indicated that they were "extremely well" prepared for continuing their education.
- 62.7% of respondents who entered the labor force said that their new job was "directly related" to their program of study.
- 51.5% of respondents rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State College as "Excellent."
- 96% of respondents indicated that their overall impression/attitude of Dalton State College was "Positive" or "Very Positive."
- 89.4% of respondents indicated that they would recommend Dalton State College to someone who wanted to major in their program.
- 59% indicated that if they could start college over, they would "definitely" choose to attend Dalton State College.
- 97.8% of respondents rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State College as "Satisfied" or "Very Satisfied."
