

2006 GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT

Highlights

- 201 graduates responded to the survey. The total number of degrees and certificates conferred in 2005-2006 was 529. Response rate for survey is approximately 40%.
- 73.6% of responding graduates were female. 68.7% of respondents were enrolled full-time, 24.4% were enrolled part-time while attending Dalton State College.
- 14.4% of students worked on campus while attending Dalton State College; 30.3% worked off-campus while attending Dalton State College, 21.4% worked 36 or more hours per week.
- 75.6% of respondents reported that their objective for attending Dalton State College was fully accomplished.
- A slight majority (28.4%) completed their degree or certificated program in two years.
- 45.3% of respondents said their immediate plans after graduation was to obtain further education.
- 20.9% of respondents indicated that they were "extremely well" prepared for continuing their education.
- 57.2% of respondents who entered the labor force said that their new job was "directly related" to their program of study.
- 43.8% of respondents rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State College as "Excellent."
- 88.1% of respondents indicated that their overall impression/attitude of Dalton State College was "Positive" or "Very Positive."
- 80.6% of respondents indicated that they would recommend Dalton State College to someone who wanted to major in their program.
- 57.2% indicated that if they could start college over, they would "definitely" choose to attend Dalton State College.
- 89% of respondents rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State College as "Satisfied" or "Very Satisfied."
