

2007 GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT

Highlights

- 284 graduates responded to the survey. The total number of degrees and certificates conferred in 2006-2007 was 555. Response rate for survey is approximately 51.1%.
- 75.7% of responding graduates were female. 76.6% of respondents were enrolled full-time, 23.0% were enrolled part-time while attending Dalton State College.
- 12.3% of students worked on campus while attending Dalton State College; 27.8% worked off-campus while attending Dalton State College, 24.6% worked 36 or more hours per week.
- 79.2% of respondents reported that their objective for attending Dalton State College was fully accomplished.
- A slight majority (25.0%) completed their degree or certificated program in four years.
- 44.0% of respondents said their immediate plans after graduation was to obtain further education.
- 32.0% of respondents indicated that they were "extremely well" prepared for continuing their education.
- 65.5% of respondents who entered the labor force said that their new job was "directly related" to their program of study.
- 57.7% of respondents rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State College as "Excellent."
- 93.0% of respondents indicated that their overall impression/attitude of Dalton State College was "Positive" or "Very Positive."
- 83.1% of respondents indicated that they would recommend Dalton State College to someone who wanted to major in their program.
- 56.3% indicated that if they could start college over, they would "definitely" choose to attend Dalton State College.
- 93.6% of respondents rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State College as "Satisfied" or "Very Satisfied."
