# DALTON STATE C O L L E G E

#### 2009 GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT

#### Highlights

- 188 graduates responded to the survey. The total number of degrees and certificates conferred in 2008-2009 was 586. Response rate for survey is approximately 32%.
- 72.3% of responding graduates were female. 73.4% of respondents were enrolled full-time, 23.9% were enrolled part-time while attending Dalton State College.
- 11.7% of students worked on campus while attending Dalton State College; 44.2% worked off-campus while attending Dalton State College, 87.8% worked 36 or more hours per week.
- 79.3% of respondents reported that their objective for attending Dalton State College was fully accomplished.
- A slight majority (25.5%) completed their degree or certificated program in two years.
- 46.8% of respondents said their immediate plans after graduation was to obtain further education.
- 22.3% of respondents indicated that they were "extremely well" prepared for continuing their education.
- 49.5% of respondents who entered the labor force said that their new job was "directly related" to their program of study.
- 88.3% of respondents rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State College as "Excellent" or "Good."
- 86% of respondents indicated that their overall impression/attitude of Dalton State College was "Positive" or "Very Positive."
- 75.4% of respondents indicated that they would recommend Dalton State College to someone who wanted to major in their program.
- 58% indicated that if they could start college over, they would "definitely" choose to attend Dalton State College.
- 88.3% of respondents rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State College as "Satisfied" or "Very Satisfied."
