



2010 FALL GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT

Highlights

- 54 graduates responded to the survey. The total number of degrees and certificates conferred in 2010 was 199. Response rate for survey is approximately 27%.
- 70.4% of responding graduates were female. 74.1% of respondents were enrolled full-time, 25.9% were enrolled part-time while attending Dalton State College.
- 7.4% of students worked on campus while attending Dalton State College; 40.7% worked off-campus while attending Dalton State College, 27.8% worked 36 or more hours per week.
- 77.8% of respondents reported that their objective for attending Dalton State College was fully accomplished.
- About 17% completed their degree or certificate program in four years.
- 55.6% of respondents said their immediate plans after graduation was to obtain further education.
- 25.9% of respondents indicated that they were “extremely well” prepared for continuing their education.
- 31.5% of respondents who entered the labor force said that their new job was “directly related” to their program of study.
- 88.9% of respondents rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State College as “Excellent” or “Good.”
- 92.6% of respondents indicated that their overall impression/attitude of Dalton State College was “Positive” or “Very Positive.”
- 79.6% of respondents indicated that they would recommend Dalton State College to someone who wanted to major in their program.
- 48.2% indicated that if they could start college over, they would “definitely” choose to attend Dalton State College.
- 94.5% of respondents rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State College as “Satisfied” or “Very Satisfied.”
