

CAMPUS LIVING AT DSC: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is Wood Valley?

A: Wood Valley is a conveniently-located apartment complex that was recently purchased by Dalton State College. Qualified individuals may apply to live in these fully furnished 1, 2 and 3 bedroom units with kitchens, on-site parking and laundry facilities.

Q: Where is Wood Valley located?

A: Wood Valley is located at 600 College Drive on the north end of campus providing convenient access to all DSC facilities, close proximity to major retailers and restaurant, and easy access to I-75.

Q: Who can live at Wood Valley?

A: Currently enrolled DSC students taking a minimum of 9 credit hours each semester may apply to live at Wood Valley.

Q: How much does it cost?

A: Complete pricing information can be found at www.daltonstate.edu/housing. Following is a summary table. All prices listed are PER STUDENT.

Q: When will I know my housing assignment?

A: Housing assignments will be mailed out in mid-July.

Q: When can I move in?

A: Students may move in on Saturday, August 13th at 8AM.

Q: Can I stay during the summer and semester breaks?

A: Yes. You may stay during the summer and semester breaks. There is an additional charge for those students who chose to stay during the summer; however, the monthly rent is also reduced.

Q: Do you have a meal plan?

A: No. We do not currently have a meal plan; however, each apartment has a fully-equipped kitchen.

Q: Do the apartments have washers and dryers?

A: Individual apartments do not have washers and dryers; however, coin-operated laundry facilities are conveniently located on site.

Q: Do the apartments have microwaves?

A: No. The apartments do not have microwaves, but you are welcome to bring one.

Q: What is included in the furnishings?

A: Each apartment includes one adjustable-height, extra-long twin-sized bed, one desk and chair, and one drawer chest per student. There are two lounge chairs, a sofa, a coffee table, an end table, and a corner table/TV stand in each living room, and a round table for each dining room.

Q: May I bring my own furnishings?

A: You may bring your own furnishing; however, none of the provided furniture can be removed from the apartments.

Q: What about insurance for my belongings?

A: Students are encouraged to purchase individual renter's insurance.

Q: May I have guests over at my apartment?

A: Yes. Residents may have guests at their apartment provided that they do not exceed fire code limits. All guests are expected to abide by the DSC Student Code of Conduct, Federal and State Laws and City ordinances. Overnight guests are limited to three consecutive nights, with no more than two visits in a one-month period. All overnight guests must be registered with the Office of Residence Life. Residents are ultimately responsible for the behavior of their guests.

Q: What do I need to bring?

A: A complete list of recommended items will be provided with your housing assignment. In addition to personal items (clothing, school supplies, toiletries and personal care items), you will need to provide your own towels, bedding, kitchen supplies, and cookware.

Q: Are you almost full?

A: We are receiving applications and contracts on a daily basis. Therefore, the sooner you apply, the better your chances of getting an apartment.
