Δ	STUDENT RIGHTS
71.	Any Student, Student Group, or Student Organization accused of a violation of the Student Code of Conduct will have the following rights:
	1. The right to receive notice of alleged violations.
	2. The right to be provided an opportunity to respond to alleged violations.
	3. The right to seek information from the Student Conduct Administrator or a hearing officer about the review of evidence and resolution processes.
	4. To be accompanied by one advisor of their choice to any meeting(s) and hearing
	<b>5.</b> To present relevant information on their behalf.
	<b>6.</b> To request relevant witnesses on their behalf.
	7. To remain silent during any investigation and/or hearing and have no interference of responsibility drawn from such silence (if a student chooses to remain silent, the meeting, investigation, and/or hearing may still proceed, and charges may be resolved formally)
	<b>8.</b> To have unrelated charges and cases resolved separately unless the student consents to have them aggregated.
	<b>9.</b> To be informed of any disciplinary outcomes in writing.
	<b>10.</b> To appeal decisions on specific grounds.
	<b>11.</b> To attend classes and required College functions until a hearing is held and a decision is rendered. Exceptions can be made when an interim suspension is imposed.

	I understand that I am entitled to have my case heard before the Student Conduct Board. I understand that if I accept the
	recommendation from the administrative hearing I waive this right.
