then membership on the Campus Activities Board (CAB) may be for you!**

### What is CAB?

The Campus Activities Board is a group of students who work with the Office of Student Activities to plan and implement social, cultural, educational, and community service events for the campus community (day and evening students). Common CAB events include: comedians, music groups, novelty events (game shows, rock walls, funny photos and videos, motion simulators, etc.), fine arts and lecture series events, and recreational opportunities (game room tournaments.)

In addition, CAB members create and plan the schedule of events for each semester. Members also attend conferences and review other resources to collect current ideas for campus programming. Creativity, a positive attitude, dependability, and a strong work ethic are a must.

### Who can be a member of CAB?

All students with at least a 1.66 GPA can be a member of CAB. However, only students with at least a 2.25 GPA can be on the Executive Board. There are two opportunities for membership in CAB:

- 1) **Executive Board Positions:** Seven paid leadership positions are available for student leaders who want to work six hours per week in the Office of Student Activities to plan and implement events for DSC students. Students in these positions will establish a weekly work schedule (hours are flexible with class schedules). In addition, students will attend an activities conference. These positions are VERY LIMITED. Only executive board members who are selected through an exclusive interview process are eligible for paid positions.
- 2) **Volunteer Positions:** This is an opportunity for students who have interest in assisting with campus activities programming on a volunteer basis. CAB volunteers will meet twice a month and assist projects/events that fit their schedules. Meetings are scheduled the first and third Tuesday of every month.

What Can I Learn From Being a Member of CAB?

**CAB members will learn about budgeting, planning, organizing, promoting, and working as a team. No experience is required to be a member. We are looking for enthusiastic, motivated students who want to provide quality programming at DSC.**

How Can I Apply for CAB Membership?

**Complete and return the attached application. Students interested in paid positions will be contacted regarding their applications. Students interested in volunteer CAB positions will be notified of the first CAB meeting.**
