Rock Policy

1. Only the Rock is allowed to be painted. Trees, grass, and mulch around the Rock are off limits.
2. The entire Rock must be painted.
3. The background color of all expressions on the Rock must be **navy blue** or **silver**.
4. Any other substance other than paint is NOT allowed on the Rock.
5. Guarding the Rock to try to prevent others from painting it is not allowed. No group/person shall stop another from painting the rock.
6. Tents or chairs cannot be set up at the Rock.
7. The Rock can be repainted thirty (30) seconds after the previous painting group/person has completed painting the rock, with event date exceptions. *
8. A group/person is considered finished when he/she/they are no longer painting the Rock.
9. Only written or artistic free speech can be used at the Rock.
10. No reservations are needed to paint the rock. It can be painted any day or night at any time.

* If an event is being advertised on the rock and the date of the event is stated on the Rock's surface, no one is to paint over the Rock's surface IF, and only if, the event is one week into the future or less. If the event date is more than one week in the future of when another group/person wants to paint the Rock, he/she/they can paint the Rock.
