## **LPN Application Instructions – Department of Nursing**

The online application for the Spring LPN cohort will open July 15 and will remain open until October 15 annually. The online application for the Summer LPN cohort will open December 1 and remain open until March 10 annually.

## (Please read the instructions below carefully before you complete the application. Applicants must meet all instructions below to be eligible for class selection).

- Complete the Dalton State College admission process by the application deadline. Application for admission is available at <u>https://www.daltonstate.edu/admissions/application.cms</u>. Applicants must be officially accepted to Dalton State prior to submitting an application to the LPN program. Applicants should verify with the Registrar's office that ALL transcripts have been received and evaluated by the Registrar's office before applying to the LPN program. Applicants must have exited (or exempted) all areas of Learning Support by the application deadline.
- 2. Submission of the online LPN Application by the application deadline. Applicants must have an active Dalton State email account to apply.
- 3. The overall GPA earned at the time of application will be used for ranking purposes. The GPA must be at least 2.50.
- 4. Completion of Biology 1100 OR Biology 2251K (2212K), English 1101, and either Math 1001, Math 1101, Math 1111, OR Math 1113 with a grade of C or better by the time you submit your application. The letter grade from these courses will be used to compute your points on the admission worksheet. Students who have taken Biology 2251K (2212K) must complete Biology 2252K (2213K) by the end of their first semester in the program. It is encouraged to complete both Biology 2251K and 2252K before applying to the program. Beginning Spring 2024, Dalton State will accept transfer credit for BIOL 2251K, BIOL 2252K, and BIOL 2260K from the Technical College System of Georgia.
- 5. 50<sup>th</sup> percentile or above on the TEAS Test Overall Percentage. TEAS scores must be obtained within the last three years and must be submitted by the application deadline.
- 6. Applicants with current CNA certification will receive one (1) additional point on the admission worksheet.
