Please Note:

1. Dalton State encourages all students to take between 30-33 hours per year to graduate in four years. Dalton State offers a spring and fall nursing cohort.
2. Must have at least 6 months of working experience in their last field of study (ASN) before applying.
3. 30 Hours of Core Curriculum must be completed prior to the start of the BSN Program. The courses with an ****** are **required pre-requisites** for a total of 21 hours plus 9 more hours to meet the 30 hours of pre-requisites.
4. Program-accepted students will be required to complete clinical hours during the daytime, nighttime or weekends.
5. Program-accepted students must meet the following clinical requirements:
 - Completed Health History and Physical Form
 - TB Screening
 - Urine Drug Screen
 - Mandatory Health Professional CPR certification through the American Heart Association.
 - Students must maintain ability to meet requirements of Nursing Practice Performance Standards/Essential Abilities.
 - Nursing Department Immunization Form
 - Criminal Background Check
 - Other Health Screenings
