Dear Dr. Sightler:

I am writing to notify the Commission on Colleges of the discovery of an unreported substantive change. In June 2020, the Academic Programs Committee of Dalton State College approved the reactivation (reopening) of the college's Associate of Applied Science in Integrated Tech Studies program, effective Fall of 2020, following an unreported closure in 2019 which has been submitted separately. The reactivation was premised on a potential agreement involving a transfer pathway from our institution to another. Our SACSCOC Institutional Accreditation Liaison at the time believed that a program reactivation did not constitute a program re-opening. As such, we did not submit a program re-opening notification to SACSCOC in compliance with the SACSCOC Substantive Change policy. In reviewing past actions as part of our Compliance Certification self-study, our new liaison identified the error.

We have included information in the enclosure as would be required for a re-opening notification.

Therefore, the students in this program will be enrolling in courses that are normally offered at Dalton State and will utilize existing resources, including instructional space and equipment, financial resources, library and learning/information resources, and student support services. In addition, the chosen courses will be taught by faculty who are qualified in the discipline.
