



Where do I schedule for the TEAS?


TEAS exams are scheduled through the [ATI website](#).

How do I schedule?

- 1) Navigate to the online store after logging into your account. If you do not have an account, you will need to create one.



- 2) Select TEAS.



- 3) Enter information for your program and location.

What is Remote Proctoring?

Remote proctoring allows you to take the TEAS exam from home on a laptop or desktop computer equipped with a webcam.

What are the technical requirements of Remote Proctoring?

ATI provides the following information:

Before the exam, the school will provide you with the assessment ID (please check your email for communication from the Institution). If you do not have an assessment/product ID within 24 hours of your scheduled date/time, please contact the school/center who is administering the TEAS test. Check testing location website for specific testing restrictions/details BEFORE purchasing. All TEAS registrations are final, no refunds or reschedules.

Before you take the exam, please read the following information in its entirety. *Note: If certain tech requirements are not met prior to testing, you will have to do so during your test time.***

Before test day:

Before your exam day, ensure that you are able to meet the following technical requirements:

- **Microphone:** Any microphone, either internal or external
- **Webcam:** 320x240 VGA resolution (minimum) internal or external
- **Desktop of laptop computer – NO iPads, tablets or phones are to be used – with the ability to download Google Chrome**

Prior to exam start time:

As you await the start time of your exam, set yourself up for success by doing the following:

- **Ensure you are using a fully charged laptop or desktop computer with a webcam and microphone.**

- **Install Google Chrome on your device. You will not be able to take the remote version of the ATI TEAS Exam with Proctorio using any other browser.**
- **Have a government-issued ID card available.**
- **Find a well-lit space, and be ready for a room scan prior to the assessment.**
- **Prepare one piece of blank paper to be used during the exam. Please destroy the paper upon completion.**

How do I prepare my computer for testing?

- 1) Install and test Proctorio; clear your browser history, cookies, and cache; and complete the Dry Run.



IMPORTANT! Before you begin a remote proctored test:

Install and test Proctorio by taking **Remote Proctoring Dry Run**, a Practice Assessment available on the TEST tab.

Also, be sure to perform the following steps in your Google Chrome Browser. (Click [here](#) for the video or find additional troubleshooting on the **SUPPORT** menu.)

Clear Browser History, Cookies and Cache:


- • PC: **CTRL+SHIFT+DELETE** or Mac: **SHIFT+COMMAND+DELETE**
- • Change Time range: **All time**
- • Click **Clear Data**

Make sure your internet connection is reliable and you meet these requirements:


- • **PC** (Windows 10 or later) or a **Mac** (Mac OS® x 10.13 or later)
- • **Browser:** Google Chrome
- • **Microphone:** Any microphone, either internal or external
- • **Webcam:** 320 x 240 VGA resolution, either internal or external
- • **Internet Speed:** 0.5 – 1.0 Mbps. (Test your internet speed using www.speedtest.net)

How do I access the Dry Run?

- 1) Click My ATI.



2) Click Test.



3) Locate the practice assessment labeled Remote Proctoring Dry Run and click Begin.
