

Program Pathway – Associates of Science – Nursing (ASN)

This degree is considered entry-level into nursing practice for registered nurses. From infants to the elderly, RNs assess, plan, and deliver care to patients in many specialized areas. They may work in medical-surgical, emergency, intensive/critical, labor and delivery, mother-baby, or in the operating room/post-anesthesia nursing care units. RNs may work in hospitals, home health, mental health, industrial health, public health, schools, physicians' offices, outpatient surgery centers, etc. The possibilities for nurses with an ASN are abundant, and nurses can move from one setting to another as their interests and lives change.

This map is a semester-by-semester sample course schedule. It is strongly advised that students make every effort to pass these courses on the first attempt with a "C" or higher in order to be successful in this program. The milestones listed below each year are designed to keep you on course to graduate in four years. Missing milestones could prevent you from being eligible for a particular program or could result in a delay in graduation. The Program Pathway serves as a general guideline to help you build a full schedule each term.
