

Program Pathway - *Bachelor of Science – Nursing (RN-BSN)*

This map is a semester-by-semester sample course schedule. It is strongly advised that students make every effort to pass these courses on the first attempt with a "C" or higher in order to be successful in this program. The milestones listed below each year are designed to keep you on course to graduate in four years. Missing milestones could prevent you from being eligible for a particular program or could result in a delay in graduation. The Program Pathway serves as a general guideline to help you build a full schedule each term.

To be eligible to participate in this program, a student must meet the following criteria:

Graduation from an ASN or diploma program with the past four (4) years, or graduation from an ASN program or diploma program more than four (4) years ago with documentation of 1,000 hours of practice within the last three years.
